DESCRIPTION

IB-3 ShingleStarter™ is a 36" wide, self-adhering, mineral surface starter shingle that serves the dual function of replacing conventional starter strips, as well as providing ice and water dam protection in cold climates. The specially formulated rubberized asphalt adhesive seals around nails. IB-3 ShingleStarter has two self-sealing tabs, located 1.5" nominally from both edges. The sealing tabs feature a removable release liner to protect the adhesive until the shingle installation. The roll is also backed with a protective release liner, which is split for easy valley applications.

USES

IB-3 ShingleStarter installs under shingles, tile and other types of roofing to protect from leaks due to ice dams, melting snow and blowing rain. It is suitable for use in new construction and reroofing. Apply directly to the roof deck at:

- Valleys
- Skylights
- Eaves
- Chimnevs
- Ridges
- Anywhere extra protection is needed
- Vents

GENERAL INSTALLATION NOTES

This is a summary of how the product is installed. Complete Installation Instructions are available at www.mfmbp.com.

- Apply at ambient temperatures above 40°F
- Apply to decks having a minimum slope of 2" per foot
- The surface must be smooth, clean, dry and free of contaminants
- Always prime weathered OSB, masonry, aged metal and concrete surfaces with an MFM-approved primer to achieve good adhesion
- MFM Low-VOC Spray Adhesive™ may be used to improve adhesion
- THE CONTRACTOR MUST DETERMINE WHETHER ADHESION IS ADEQUATE BEFORE PROCEEDING
- Starting at the low point of the roof deck, align roll with the edge of the roof, peel back the release liner from the back of the membrane and press into place
- If using a drip edge, the membrane should be installed to be flush with the drip edge, and the first course of shingles installed per the shingle manufacturer's instructions
- The sealing strips contain a protective release liner that should NOT be removed until the installation of the shingles – the release liner prevents dust from accumulating on the sealing strip to maintain the effectiveness of the adhesive – simply pull to easily remove
- Overlap ends at least 6" and if applying more than one course, make sure that the side laps are overlapped at least 3" and installed so water runs over the lap seam
- Prior to lapping the ends, cover the 6" lap area with a continuous application of asphalt roofing mastic to ensure a watertight seal – for the side seam, a continuous application of asphalt roofing mastic must be applied to the side lap to assure a watertight seal

WARNINGS

- Store in cool dry place
- Use caution when walking on installed IB-3 ShingleStarter and roof deck
- Membrane is a vapor barrier allow for proper ventilation of the ridge and soffit
- Keep product out of direct sunlight
- Store in original carton until ready to use
- Product may be left exposed for up to 30 days
- DO NOT use solvent-based or silicone caulking
- DO NOT install over solvent-based sealants unless fully cured active solvents may liquefy bottom adhesive surface
- DO NOT install over PVC or silicone roofing materials
- Installer is responsible for compatibility with caulks and sealants
