

# **Technical Information**

**MFM Building Products Corp.** manufactures a wide range of innovative waterproofing products for the building industry. Founded in 1961, MFM products are engineered for superior performance and ease of installation.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

IB-4 is a self-adhesive mineral surface underlayment which is adhered directly to the roof deck. The specially formulated rubberized asphalt adhesive self-seals around roofing nails and forms a long-lasting barrier. IB-4 is backed with a protective release liner which removes easily during application. The release liner is split in the center for easy valley applications. The granular surface covers a high strength mat which is coated with a rubberized asphalt compound. Granules are applied to the top surface for an improved walking surface. An adhesive selvedge edge allows for a secure seal on overlaps.

#### USES

IB-4 installs under shingles, tile, and most roofing materials to protect from leaks due to water and wind-driven rain. Suitable for new construction and reroofing, IB-4 protects the roof and won't crack or dry out. Apply directly to the roof deck or at eaves, valleys, vents, skylights and chimneys. IB-4 may be installed across the entire roof as a secondary water barrier with proper ventilation.

### INSTALLATION

IB-4 StormStopper should be applied in fair weather conditions with temperatures greater than 40°F. The surface must be clean, dry and smooth. Broom substrate clean and apply product. Prime masonry, weathered OSB, aged metal and concrete surfaces with an MFM-approved primer. MFM Low-VOC Spray Adhesive™ may be used to improve adhesion. If IB-4 is not covered immediately, seal end laps with roofing mastic to assure a watertight seal. Recommended minimum slope for installation is 2" per foot. Before applying second course, remove protective liner on sealing edge.

## **WARNINGS**

- Roof work is dangerous work carefully and use caution when walking on installed IB-4 StormStopper and the roof deck
- IB-4 is a vapor barrier allow for proper ventilation of the ridge and soffit
- Store IB-4 in original carton until ready to use
- Keep product dry and out of direct sunlight
- IB-4 must be covered within 365 days
- DO NOT use solvent-based or silicone caulking
- DO NOT install over solvent-based sealants unless fully cured

   active solvents may liquefy bottom adhesive surface
- DO NOT install over PVC or silicone roofing materials
- Installer is responsible for compatibility with caulks and sealants
- MFM will not warranty product when used on plank or tongue-and-groove boards that are not cured and still contain tree resin – resin is not compatible with the asphalt adhesive and will liquify it
